

T.L.C. Preschool Community Scholarship Guidelines

One \$250 award will be presented to an Orion High School senior who will be attending a two- or four-year college during the fall semester of 2018. The student must also have attended T.L.C. Preschool for at least one year.

I. Selection Process:

- A. Candidates will be judged based on a point system outlined in Section II.
- B. The T.L.C. Preschool Board of Directors will appoint a review board of at least three board members.
- C. All applications must be returned to the OHS Guidance Counselor's office by the date indicated on the application form.
- D. All essays **MUST BE TYPED**.
- E. Payment of the scholarship will be made to the student upon verification of enrollment (copy of tuition bill and copy of class schedule) for the Fall Semester of the 2016-2017 school year.
- F. The winning student will be announced by OHS Graduation.

II. The basis for judging the winner will be the following 100 point system:

- A. (60 points) All candidates must submit an original essay (minimum 500 words) with the application, describing how their current success in school and/or life can be traced to one or more of the goals of T.L.C. Preschool (see attached Goal Sheet)
- B. (30 points) Character, personal development, and leadership qualities evaluated as follows:
 1. 10 points awarded for overall school activities
 2. 5 points awarded for non-school activities
 3. 15 points awarded for leadership qualities
- C. (10 points) Grade point average using the following formula
 1. Cumulative GPA x 10/4 = point total (based on A = 4.0 scale)
